AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 104 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHLEY, BY THE REPEAL OF SECTION II, PARAGRAPH B, WHICH CREATED A SURCHARGE FOR WATER SERVICE CUSTOMERS WITH SWIMMING POOLS

THE VILLAGE OF ASHLEY ORDAINS

- 1. **Repeal.** Paragraph B of Section II of Ordinance No. 104 is hereby repealed.
- 2. <u>Separability.</u> If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
- 3. <u>Ordinances Repealed</u>. All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- 4. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force fifteen days from and after its enactment as provided by the Village council.
