September 12, 2024

The regular council meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Ann Paksi.

Roll call was taken with, Ann Paksi, Dave Foote, Robert Studt, , Mike Turner, David Kimball, Andrew Brown, Chris Lambert-Deputy Clerk, Michelle Fitzpatrick-Clerk/Treasurer, Absent: Paul Beck-DPW Supervisor, Doug Schneider

Visitors: Resident/Business Owner of Hinterland Haunted House Matt Stehlik presented with the request for the Noise Ordinance due to his business hours are past the Noise Ordinance time frame.

After review and discussion council gave Hinterland Haunted House an exception for the noise ordinance.

After review and discussion Sculptures erected within the community has been tabled for further discussion.

Trustee R. Studt stated that Wade Trim contacted him to make the village aware of grant opportunities for housing on the water tower property, Water tower property was reviewed and discussed.

New Business:

Budget meetings were discussed and a time will be set in October to start meeting for next Fiscal Year budget.

Deputy Clerk Lambert stated that Wagon Wheel food truck requested setting up a stand within the village limits.
